At the center, a gracefully modeled winged bronze cherub serves as both a decorative and functional element. The side edges of the base are finished with floral garlands in chiseled bronze. The craftsmanship reveals the high-quality construction and decorative attention characteristic of the Sèvres manufactory, marked by a successful fusion of the delicacy of porcelain and the sturdiness of gilded bronze.
