



## Antique Victorian Sterling Silver Pedestal Bowl Sheffield 1895 Atkin Bros

### Description

An antique sterling silver pedestal bowl of circular form, manufactured in Sheffield, England, in 1895 by the silversmithing firm Atkin Brothers. The bowl features a flared, scalloped rim and a body decorated with high-relief repoussé work. This ornamentation consists of naturalistic floral clusters, large blossoms, and acanthus leaf motifs set against a finely stippled background. These decorative elements surround two symmetrical, polished-silver vacant cartouches located on opposite sides of the exterior. The bowl is supported by a short, conforming pedestal foot which is also finished with an embossed band of matching foliate and scroll decorations. The interior of the bowl is a smooth, polished silver surface. Struck clearly onto the side of the body are four British
