Rare tapestry from Oudenaarde, Flanders, 16th century. Fantastic and real animals, with griffin and lynx. We observe a hybrid animal (griffin type, chimera: bird's head and wings with lion's body facing a stylized lynx or leopard spotted feline) In a lush forest background, densely wooded landscape with a village in perspective. This decor was intended to adorn castles, rather than a specific story. Animal greenery or greenery with ferocious beasts. Renaissance greenery not yet Baroque, Italian influence with decor of vertical garlands à stylized fruits and flowers surrounded by decorative figures inlaid in niches finely drawn. Beautifully fresh green and ochre color palette .
