Very attractive 18th century console table, probably Provençal work, in richly molded and carved walnut, resting on an elegant double-movement cambered base of rare visual lightness. This piece immediately captivates with its balanced proportions and small size, particularly sought-after today, allowing it to easily find its place in a refined interior, both classic and contemporary. The curved front is embellished with a delicate carved decoration of shells and scrolls, typical of the southern rocaille taste of the XVIIIe century. The walnut has a beautiful antique patina with warm, deep shades, highlighting the quality of the grain as well as the craftsmanship of Provençal cabinetmaking. The base, full of curves and counter-curves, lends the ensemble great elegance and remarkable finesse.
