Oil on canvas, signed lower left. Dimensions: 38 x 30 cm. Forceful animal study depicting the hindquarters of a horse in the dark atmosphere of a stable. With a broad, nervous brushstroke, Gustave Colsoulle aptly renders the animal's power, as well as the effects of light on the coat and straw. The composition, deliberately designed to be a work of art, is a perfect complement to the painting. The composition, deliberately tight and intimate, evokes the naturalistic research of the animal painters of the second half of the XIXe century. The contrasts between the deep brown tones and the golden accents of the straw create a warm, rustic atmosphere that is particularly decorative.
