It is presented in its original gilded wood frame with palmettes and oval shape. Early Empire period, circa 1805-1810. Our portrait depicts a young man from the bourgeoisie or aristocracy, very handsome, his face finely represented (beautiful brown eyes, a gentle gaze, a beauty spot on the cheek, Titus-style hair also finely represented). The blue habit makes it colorful and cheerful, the oval format in its beautiful original frame makes the whole very elegant. A lovely amateur portrait.
