Description

- Round-form pot holder in hard polychrome porcelain with two cartouches depicting two scenes, one gallant with a young man and two young women in the park of the Petit Trianon at Versailles, signed in the decoration by the painter decorator Heny on a Sèvres blue background. The other scene after a representation of the farm in the Queen's hamlet at Versailles.- Neck of the cache-pot encircled with copper and ormolu chased and guilloche openwork at the oval neck.- Base of the cache-pot with curved corners, chased and guilloche in ormolu with a laurel leaf garland and braces. - Rich gold decoration of trumpet, cornucopia, palm, arabesque, scrolls, flowering garlands around the gallant scene cartouche and hamlet farm cartouche. - Gold leaf frieze around the neck of the pot cover under the bronze mount.
