Decorative plate in lacquered wood with "Arte Povera" print applications. Turin, 18th century. Ø 51 cm. A rare decorative plate in wood, a fine example of the Piedmontese lacca povera tradition of the 18th century. The technique involved the application of small hand-coloured engravings onto a wooden support, subsequently sealed with transparent varnish layers as an economical alternative to costly Oriental lacquerware. The decoration is arranged in concentric registers: at the centre, within a roundel on a turquoise ground, a bucolic landscape with trees and architectural elements; in the intermediate band on a vermillion ground, four large polylobed cartouches enclose architectural capriccios with bridges, obelisks and ruins, enriched by naturalistic elements.
