Stunning glazed ceramic bowl or vide-poche featuring a set of stylized hands supporting a bowl with freely moving contours. This sculptural composition with its expressive modeling illustrates all the decorative power of Cazaux's work, where the utilitarian object becomes sculpture. The hands, treated in a synthetic and rhythmic manner, compose a powerful and singular decoration, evoking a gesture of offering or protection. The shaded enamel in shades of pinkish ivory, beige and brown emphasizes the reliefs and reinforces the organic character of the whole. The bowl features a deliberately animated irregular rim, participating in the expressiveness of the piece. The underside bears a signature incisé de
