Description

Small gilt bronze and pink enamel jewelry box, XIXth century period. Charming circular cylindrical box in finely chased and gilt bronze, resting on an elegant openwork structure decorated with interlaced motifs. The lid is adorned with a central medallion featuring the miniature portrait of a young elegant lady, delicately treated in the spirit of the XVIIIe century portraits so prized under the Second Empire. The portrait is framed by an elegant guilloché pink enamel surround, whose refined hue contrasts harmoniously with the warm glow of the gilding. The circumference of the lid is enriched with a finely chased frieze of foliage and floral motifs, testifying to the quality of craftsmanship of this precious piece. The interior, preserved in remarkable condition, is fitted with a
