An 18th-century Meissen porcelain teapot and cover, circa 1750, with gilt animal/bird head spout and roccaille handle, decorated with Deutsche Blumen and individual flowers, the cover with flower finial. Measurements: Height: 11 cm (4.3 in)Length: 18 cm (7.1 in)Width: 10.5 cm (4.1 in)Condition (Please note that we have a "no unpleasant surprises" policy regarding condition reports and try to list all defects, however small): There is one petal and the edge of another lost from the flower finial of the cover, which matches the teapot but appears to be a fractionally brighter white than the body, so we are unsure whether it is a replacement. There is a tiny, pin-point sized mark that feels rough to the touch on the upper rim of the teapot aperture and a tiny firing flaw beneath it on the inner rim.
