Highly decorative, this vase perfectly illustrates the revival of French decorative arts between the wars and the taste for stylized floral compositions characteristic of Saint-Sever's productions..Height: 15 cm Very good condition. Louis Dage (1885-1963) was a French ceramist and decorator associated with the Art Deco movement. Trained in Beauvais, then working in Antony before collaborating with the Saint-Sever workshops, from the 1920s he
