Elegant oak side table or small coffee table, created in the taste of Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin furniture. This piece is distinguished by its sober, powerful geometric architecture, composed of a rectangular top resting on a structured base with vertical uprights and horizontal crosspieces, creating a play of lines typical of the American modernist aesthetic inspired by the famous architect. The beautiful warm patina of the oak underlines the quality of the grain and reinforces the sculptural character of the whole. This table directly evokes the Taliesin furniture creations developed in the entourage of Frank Lloyd Wright, where architecture and furniture dialogue in the same quest for horizontality, structural simplicity and organic integration of materials.
