Large circular tray in Breche du Bénou marble dating from the 1970s, featuring spectacular natural polychromy blending shades of pink, blue-gray, beige and ivory. The particularly expressive mineral pattern creates an all-natural abstract composition, making this piece a true decorative element in its own right. Presented here on a transparent plexiglass base, available as an extra, this tray can be used as a pedestal table top, coffee table or side table. Very sought-after in the 1970s for its spectacular appearance, Brèche du Bénou marble is appreciated for its exploded veining and unique chromatic palette. Each tray constitutes a singular piece, the natural veining forming an abstract setting akin to a mineral painting. The combination with a transparent plexiglass base accentuates the effect of lightness
