Description

Blown amber glass truncated vase lightly ribbed and entirely hand-worked. Corolla neck adorned with ten fine curved lines. Two finely hemmed hot-applied handles prolonged with an applied vertical motif worked with tongs. Two six-petal medallion flowers on the bottom of the vase. Pontil marks on the bottom. Gordiola glass workshop in Majorca. One of a kind. First third of the 20th century. Perfect condition. Height: 20.8 cm. Width: 17.5 cm. Diameter: 14 cm. Since 1719, the famous Gordiola family has mastered the art of glassblowing with prodigious skill. So much so that today the prestigious blown glass from the Gordiola glassworks is part of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity by Unesco.
