### Description

This Transition-style coffee table seduces with the refined elegance of its rosewood and mahogany marquetry. The top, composed of a butterfly-winged veneer framed by a two-tone frieze, offers a subtle and luminous play of symmetries. The scalloped edge underlines the finesse of its line and highlights the work of the master cabinetmaker. The drawer at the waist features a rosewood veneer front enhanced by a two-tone fillet, and opens with a finely chased bronze handle in the shape of a laurel wreath, a noble and delicate detail that affirms the precious character of the piece. Underneath, a door with a raised inlaid front reveals a spacious niche that provides discreet functionality while preserving the harmony of the piece. The rounded uprights, adorned with inlaid blackened wood fillet, extend
