Superb precious rosewood veneer with continuous, warm horizontal veining (brown/mahogany shades). Contrasting interior in light sycamore wood. Asymmetrical front: A showcase section on the left with shelves to display your objets d'art. A bar area with flap, ideal for flasks and glassware. A large secretary with central flap opening onto a compartmentalized storage locker (niches, drawer, mail holder). Large storage spaces at the bottom, closed by doors with original gilded brass handles. Inlaid with rosewood. Frame : Stylized cutaway base typical of the period, highlighted by a gilded brass rush that adds a touch of light. In
