19th-century oil on panel depicting a path passing beneath a ruined tower. The work is signed lower left by Gustave Castan artist born 1823 in Geneva, died 1892 in Crozant (Creuse). Landscape painter, engraver, lithographer, illustrator. He began his artistic studies under Calame, whom he followed to Italy in 1845. He then moved to Paris, then traveled to France, Belgium; exhibited in Vienna, Austria, Turin, Paris, etc. Influenced by Corot, he lightened his palette, frequently using gray tones for his bare rocks. He is very well referenced and features in many Swiss and French museums, such as Chambéry, Lille, Langres. Panel dimensions, 40.5 cm x 32 cm.
