Description

This elegant hexagonal Delft faience vase, likely produced in the Netherlands during the early 20th century (circa 1900-1930), beautifully reflects the enduring tradition of hand-decorated Delftware. Marked to the underside "Delft", the piece appears to originate from a Dutch Delft pottery workshop, executed in the classic cobalt blue palette on a creamy white glazed ground. The vase features a striking architectural landscape panel depicting a picturesque waterside scene with a historic tower or manor beside calm waters, accompanied by delicate foliage and a small sailing boat in the

distance. The composition evokes the romantic charm of traditional Dutch scenery often celebrated in Delft ceramics. Rich cobalt borders frame the central reserve, accented with stylized floral ornamentation and sculptural relief details, lending the vase an elegant decorative presence. Its unusual hexagonal form, gently flared rim, and finely painted floral decoration to the sides and reverse enhance its sculptural appeal, making it attractive both as a decorative standalone object and as a vessel for flowers. The slightly raised molded motifs and deep blue glazing create beautiful contrast and visual depth. Dating from the first quarter of the 20th century, this vase represents a refined interpretation of traditional Delft craftsmanship, blending decorative artistry with architectural scenic painting. A sophisticated accent for collectors of Delftware, Dutch ceramics, or blue and white decorative objects.
