With experience as a sculptor and engraver, he debuted at the 1833 Salon, where he exhibited until 1868. Decorated with the Knight's Cross of the Legion of Honor. His themes were varied, and he excelled at painting flowers, history and genre scenes. The painting we present is a magnificent still life with flowers and an allegory of the poppy flower and its use with the hookah.
