This tankil bracelet comes from the northern island of Luzon in the Philippines. The jewelry consists of boar tusks joined by rattan braiding and surmounted by a rare double anthropomorphic wooden figurine. An armless figure with a torso decorated with engraved tattoos rests on the head of a crouching figure. Men wore this bracelet on their upper arm during ritual ceremonies related to headhunting.
