FIXED COVERED VASE UNDER GLASS, internally decorated with glued engravings of butterflies, birds, reptiles and Chinese ancestors in polychrome on a cream background, in the "potichomanie" style. Turinese arte povera production. Blown glass baluster form Turin, 18th century. Height: 31 cm - (Visible missing parts) Potichomania: the practice of decorating glass vases in imitation of Chinese potiches with cut-out paper images applied to the inside. Such was, in the 18th century, the fashion for perfuming and cut-outs, which has been reproduced today under the name of decalcomania, potichomanie[...] - (Journal officiel Jan. 8, 1876, page 205, 3rd column - quoted by Littré)
