Pair of six-light candelabra in regule and patinated and gilded bronze. Elegant pair of Napoleon III / Louis XVI style candelabra, richly decorated with neoclassical motifs and winged cherubs in regule and patinated bronze. Each candelabra features a substantial structure with six finely moved arms of light, adorned with rooster heads, foliage and rocaille scrolls. The baluster shafts in a deep red hue provide a refined contrast with the gilded and silvered patinated parts. The quadrangular base rests on claw-decorated feet and receives a large ornamental medallion on the front. Two small cherubs support flowery garlands around the central vase. Very fine decorative presence, forming a harmonious ensemble with the matching clock. Mid-twentieth-century decorative
