Both feature two drawers and two doors, ergonomically designed and ideal for storing small items. A further touch of refinement is provided by the inlays, featuring geometric bands and floral motifs, on the sides, top, and front. The corners and feet are also decorated with floral and geometric inlays. This pair of bedside tables exudes great taste and refinement, adding a touch of class and antique appeal to any space.
