A carved wooden churn guide - Himalayan regions, probably Nepal. Himalayan folk art, this object was used as a churn guide in milk processing. Mid 20th century or earlier.

Vernacularly called ghurra or neti. Representation of a man, phallus apparent, carrying what appears to be a rock. Possibly the representation of a local myth. Weight 139gr Length 23.5cm
