Dame and Les Saintes Maries Yves Brayer , a
renowned painter , achieved success at an early
age, winning the Prix Chenavard in 1927 for his
painting "le manège d'equitation" Having
criss-crossed Provence throughout his life, he
became a master of Mediterranean light, with a
palette of nuanced colors His watercolors are
fluid and the horses' mounts are noble. (He knew
horses, having been a pupil at the military school)
