Ducker's landscapes of Barbizon and Great Britain showcase the diverse facets of the Scottish and British countryside. [10] Many of the painter's documented works feature a palette of soft, earthy colors, highlighting the atmospheric and rusty hues of the Scottish Highlands. [11] Ducker's scenes are often idyllic and evoke a similar compositional structure. [11] The Rocky Mountains are often a focal point, with particular attention paid to other natural elements such as gnarled and leafy trees, low shrubs, tall green grasses, and tranquil lakes and ponds. sometimes depicts wild birds and grazing animals, such as sheep, as well as the farmers who tend to them. Most of Ducker's documented brushwork is moderately precise, with meticulously controlled details applied with a fine brush or similar medium. In the documented paintings, Ducker tends to sign the canvas in the lower left or right corners with the signature "JMDucker" or "JDucker," sometimes emphasizing his last name.
