Description

Late 19th century solid silver contour Imari style large porcelain dish. A crossroads of cultures, this Imari style large porcelain dish comes from a French porcelain factory in the late 19th century. The mastery of porcelain and kaolin, which had long been a mystery to Europe, became a reality in the 19th century, when a new competition was created: the production of Japanese-style porcelain by European & French workshops. Monogrammed FF in the cookie on the reverse, this dish certainly comes from French porcelain factories such as Limoges. Its Imari-style decoration is very successful, the particularity of this dish being its rim mounted in solid silver with the Minerva hallmark, probably to hide the rough appearance of the rims. Its purpose is totally decorative, intended to be
