of note: among the dinner plates, 3 examples are of more recent manufacture and feature a slightly lighter sky-blue hue than the rest of the service. This difference is discreet but worth noting; please refer to the photographs. It should also be pointed out that all the dinner plates have an external gilding pattern slightly different from that observed on the other pieces of the service. Please refer to the detailed photographs. Condition: Overall very well preserved. no chips; no cracks; no hair; some light gilding wear on some pieces; some wear scratches on the basin of some plates; some pieces appear to have been used very little, if at all; others show only very light wear related to time.
