Rectangular glazed ceramic pediment mirror by Mithé Espelt (1923-2020) a famous figure in French ceramics from Lunel. This large model (37 x 22 cm) features a symmetrical composition with two stylized fantastical birds called Peacocks or Birds of Paradise. Caramel brown color.
