Description

Charming mid-19e century parasol, whose silk canvas and the lace has been replaced. It is therefore in perfect condition and a use is quite possible today. The handle is made of wood on the upper part and carved bone on the lower part, ending in a fine greyhound head. The umbrella features two ingenious systems typical of the period:- An upper metal ring allowing the canvas to be tilted when open..- A central ring to fold the parasol in half the parasol in two, for easy storage or access to a carriage. It measures 24,8 inches long closed and approximately 22,44 inches in diameter open. France, circa 1860.

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
