Description

Gilt silver tea box, it is rectangular and closes with a cylindrical dome-shaped stopper. Paris 1762-1768, perhaps 1766-1767, the letter date is not very legible. Master goldsmith François Joubert received on September 6, 1749. Weight 67g - height 7.3cm - width 4.6cm - depth 2.4cm. Condition good, a little wear to the period vermeil. It was figured in a laurel leaf in the early 19th century. A comparable tea caddy was exhibited in New York at the Metropolitan Museum, Faith Dennis, Three Centuries of French Domestic Silver, N°86 of the catalog. Rare
