### Description

A rare and highly decorative 19th-century solid wood sculpture of a warthog. Remarkably realistic and expressive, it comes either from the Swiss carving tradition or from the famous Black Forest workshops. This piece bears witness to the exceptional craftsmanship and fascination with wildlife characteristic of 19th-century Alpine decorative arts. The sculpture is finely detailed, with particular attention paid to the animal's anatomy, facial expression, tusks and surface texture. Hand-carved from solid wood, it has a rich patina that accentuates the depth and authenticity of the work. Black Forest animal sculptures are highly prized for their sculptural quality and decorative appeal.
