The carved walnut grip displays a beautiful warm antique patina, while the metal elements retain an authentic appearance consistent with the age of the piece. The case, sober yet refined, is lined with dark felt which perfectly highlights the pistol. The ensemble evokes the atmosphere of 19th century travel and the discreet personal defense weapons once kept in carriages, private desks, or travel necessities.
