Painting by Pierre BECHON-SAUZEAU, (1924-2006) Poitevin painter and member of the Salon des Artistes Français, he received several awards in 1956: In 1956-57, under the direction of Jean Cocteau, he painted the frescoes in the Chapelle St Pierre in Villefranche sur Mer and the murals in the marriage hall at Menton town hall. From 1971, the artist worked on television as a decorator, while pursuing his career as a painter and exhibiting at the Galerie St Séverin in Paris in 1974, and in Rochefort in 1976, 1980 and 1986. He created numerous sets for the Opéra, the Lido and the Théâtre de la Madeleine, as well as for television and films by famous directors such as Alain Resnais, Colline Serrault and Roman
