Oil on canvas depicting a lively view of a canal in Venice. People at the entrance to a palace, campanile in the background. The use of warm colors makes this painting very luminous! Painter Raymond Allègre hails from Marseille, where he studied at the École des Beaux-arts before moving to Paris to work in the studios of Jean Paul Laurens and Léon Bonnat. Accustomed to painting his Provence, he discovered Venice in 1900 and immediately fell in love with it. He was responsible for decorating the Train Bleu in the Gare de Lyon station. Canvas on its original stretcher, not canvas-backed.

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
