Large Venetian carved and gilded wood console table, early 19th century This console has been realized in the first of XIX century in Venice, Italy, in carved and gilded wood. The plan, recessed, is in wood painted to false marble. The console, of considerable size, has a line in the style of Louis XV, with a strongly shaped top, fascia and curved legs. On the front and laterally the band has a carved decoration with volute motifs and phytomorphic elements of Rocaille taste. The four legs are crossed by floral branches in relief and carved feet.
