Description

Wooden crucifix - Golgotha - 19th century
Oak wood table crucifix, carved and patinated
Christ on the cross is in another type of wood (probably fruit or walnut) At the foot of the cross, in keeping with the iconographic tradition of Golgotha, is Adam's skull, finely carved in the round. The titulus at the top bears the classic inscription "INRI" on a scrolled parchment
The cross rests on a moving rocaille base adorned in the center with a winged cherub face, foliate scrolls and broad volutes.
Probably a private devotional piece
XIXth century - Baroque style
Visible at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, at 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
