Description

Important sculpture of Saint Roch in carved, polychromed and gilded wood, from the South of France in the 17th century. The pilgrim saint is depicted raising the bottom of his tunic to reveal his plague bubo, accompanied at his feet by his feeder dog holding a loaf of bread in its mouth. The sculpture retains fine remnants of old polychromy and gilding. Despite old worming, some missing polychromy and restoration of the left hand. Provenance: Larminet-Davioud collection, Lille.
