Beautiful large polychrome majolica amphora vase with a white background. The vase features grotesque decorations on a blue and ochre background, and a foot also decorated with grotesque motifs mounted on an octagonal base. The vase's lid is adorned with a naked, winged cherub dancing with his right leg raised and his arms raised above his head, holding cymbals. Below the curly handles are two high-relief masks, while above the handles are seated two winged, naked cherubs with crossed legs, one playing a trumpet and the other a mandola. At the center of the vase, on both sides, are animated scenes of Venus and Cupid, depicted in an interior space and an exterior setting near a river. Harpies and grotesques are painted around these scenes on a blue background. This vase, of great
