Superb Karabag rug from Armenia in the Caucasus. Woven and knotted wool on wool. The velvet is rather short, around 5 mm, one of the distinctive features of ancient Caucasians. The central field is composed of an infinite number of stylized Boteh motifs organized horizontally and obliquely. This field is protected by a succession of 4 floral borders. This rather classic composition from this region of production also reveals a more graphic and perfectly organized dimension, the balance is total.
