Created by the painters & earthenware artisans at the Manufacture de Gien (Loiret, France), this tray with handles, with its "Rouen" decor, is a fine example of French quality in the late 19th century. The Manufacture de Gien is an internationally renowned institution in French earthenware & tableware. Founded in 1821 by English industrialist Thomas Edme Hulm, with the ambition of creating earthenware using French techniques, with an English style. Originating from Gien's golden age at the end of the 19th century, this classic model known as 'Rouen' features designs inspired by the style endemic to Rouen earthenware in Northern France, where stylized decorations of floral garlands and ears of corn are interwoven &
