Description

Pair of winged putti in carved wood probably originating from an 18th-century Baroque altarpiece or paneled element, later reused as small sellets or decorative consoles. The kneeling figures are treated as atlantes and now support rectangular trays destined for their new function. The flat reverse and overall structure indicate their former integration into a larger decor. Beautiful, highly expressive decorative carving with deeply hollowed hairs, stylized wings and movement typical of southern or central European Baroque. Antique hazelnut-brown patina with wear, old restorations and small visible accidents.
