Refectory table in solid walnut, Italy, 17th century. 299 x 57 x h 82 cm. The rectangular top, formed by two solid walnut planks set side by side, rests on two trestle supports with vertical uprights connected by a lower stretcher, following the refectory table tradition of Renaissance and Mannerist design. The feet terminate in shaped bracket supports with a curvilinear profile. The structure, entirely in solid walnut, bears a patina consistent with age and use. Condition report: Overall sound structure. Signs of use, surface abrasions, and minor losses consistent with the age of the piece. All shipments within the EU are free and professionally packed.
