Large Art Deco fir screen, circa 1930 - Esprit Baumann - 2 m x 2 m. Elegant and architectural, this remarkable 1930s folding screen seduces with the purity of its lines and the warmth of its wood. Made from fir, it is composed of four wide leaves clad in a decoration of fine vertical flutes that punctuate the surface with great elegance. Its sober, refined design is fully in keeping with the Art Deco aesthetic, while evoking the spirit of Baumann's creations, where the nobility of the material and the strength of the graphics take precedence over ornament. With its generous dimensions of 2 meters high by 2 meters deployed width, this folding screen is a true piece of interior architecture. It can be used to structure a space, create an elegant separation or simply add a strong decorative presence to a
