### Description

Pair of small ormolu and patinated candlesticks decorated with putti, attributed to the house of Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810-1892), a famous 19th-century Parisian foundryman. Each candlestick features a delicate cherub in patinated bronze base with a rich décor of foliage and foliage in Rocaille style. Rocaille-inspired foliage, finely chased and gilded with matte gold. The floral corolla-shaped rests on an openwork shaft with elegant asymmetrical movement, typical of Napoleon III's taste for revisited Louis XV models. The contrast between the dark patina of the putti and the brilliance of the gilding.
