Form: quatrefoil with suspension ring (rare form in sigillography)
Coat of arms: (Within a field of vert, a bend Or.)
The coat of arms described in the "Hispanic Community Coat of Arms Directory" features a simple, symbolic composition. The description indicates that the field is vert. On this field stands out a golden bend. The bend is one of the honored pieces in heraldry, and consists of a band that crosses the shield from the upper right corner to the lower left corner, following a diagonal line. The fact that the band is gold (yellow) adds further significance, as gold symbolizes nobility, magnanimity, power, light and wisdom.
Histories: uncommon surname scattered throughout Spain since antiquity, of families so nicknamed. In general, the tratists consulted affirm the French
