Flemish Tapestry, Oudenaarde Workshop, Late 17th Century
An important Flemish tapestry in wool and silk depicting an allegorical scene of Love, featuring two young lovers embracing within a lush wooded landscape animated by animal figures and rich vegetation. The composition unfolds in the decorative style typical of late 17th-century Flemish workshops, with great attention to naturalistic detail. At the center of the scene, the two figures, elegantly dressed in flowing, soft drapery, are immersed in an idyllic and pastoral atmosphere, evocative of the famous amorous depictions of the Renaissance and Baroque traditions. The woodland setting, populated by animals and enhanced by a luminous color scheme in shades of blue, green, and ivory, lends the work a refined

ornamental character. The tapestry is embellished with a striking border decorated with stylized motifs of flowers, fruits, and foliage. The quality of the weaving and the complexity of the composition attest to the high level of craftsmanship of the Flemish workshop, renowned throughout Europe for the production of tapestries destined for aristocratic residences.
