still features an iron frame rather than the brass frames that became standard after the 1950s. Consequently, the piece's historical integrity is fully preserved. Furthermore, the arms are shaped like stylized leaves bent into an "S" curve, also featuring rivets along the edges. The central body at the bottom consists of multiple pieces of glass blown in furnace molds and subsequently cut and polished to form the belly of the "boat." Undoubtedly, the complexity of this structure represents a sound investment that will increase in value over time. For example, the central stem rising to the ceiling consists of two ribbed glass tubes, interrupted by a geometric honeycomb pattern. Undoubtedly, the dragon-back pattern on the edges, the expanded bubbles in the center of the cups, and the iron mounting structure leave no doubt as to the authenticity of this luminous fixture (suspension chandelier) and the design by Master Ercole Barovier from 1940 in Murano, measuring 50x110xh115 cm.
