Solid rosewood cabinet covered in Havana leather from the period Art Deco period. Lower part in solid rosewood and veneer on which the upper part, entirely covered in leather. It opens with two folding doors revealing three adjustable shelves. Beautifully crafted with hinges, keyhole, handle and handle and key in gilt bronze. Lock with cremone bolt. Cabinet offered in 1935. The cabinet bears a leather plaque on the inside indicating: "The members of the board of directors of the Union des fabricants, to Mr. André Brerthaut, in memory of his 14 years as president 1921-1935." Usual restoration carried out in our workshop. In very good condition. * André Bertaut (1877-1939) President of Unifab from 1921 to 1935, son of the co-founder Léon Bertaut
